

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR THE 2020 GENERAL ELECTION

NOVEMBER 3, 2020

Oregon is a Vote-by-Mail state

September 18, 2020 - Military and Out of Country ballots mailed

September 29th - The first US Presidential debate **October 5th** - out of state ballots mailed

October 6th - LWVCorvallis - Candidates Forum - Corvallis City Council - Ward 7 7:00 PM (Zoom)

October 7th - the US Vice-presidential debate

October 13th - last day to register to vote

October 13th - Corvallis City Club City -Council/State

Representative - County Commissioners Candidates
Candidates Forum - 6:00 PM

October 14th - local ballots start being mailed

October 14th - LWVCorvallis - Candidates Forum - Benton County Commissioners 7:00PM (Zoom)

October 15th - the second US Presidential debate

October 20th - last day for county election officials to mail ballots to voters

October 22nd - the third US Presidential debate
October 27th - recommended last day to safely return
ballots by mail

October 28th - voters asked to use ballot drop sites to return ballots from here forward

November 3rd - ELECTION DAY - ballots must be returned to election offices by 8:00PM - POSTMARKS DO NOT COUNT

Ballots may be returned by: Dropping it off at any official ballot dropsite in Oregon.
